Monday 11 th Sept	<p>Introduction</p> <p>Sunday Gospel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each Sunday during your confirmation programme collect a newsletter – and, if available, a copy of the Wednesday Word from the table where the younger children’s newsletter ‘Look’ is kept. • Check out the parish blog for any family activity <p>Reading the Sunday Gospel</p> <p>You will hear the gospel – and probably some reflections on it – at Mass.</p> <p>When you get home look at the Gospel again, and read through the Wednesday Word.</p> <p>Make a note of what seems to you most important – and write your prayer to God in response to what you have read and what it says to you.</p>
Monday 18 th Sept	<p>Your Baptism/ Your Confession/Your Communion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Bring with you any photographs you have of your baptism; baptism book; baptism candle</i> • <i>Think back to the time of your first confession and first Communion. What do you remember? What did it/does it mean to you?</i>

Monday 2 nd October	Praying the Mass I Preparing

Monday 30 th October	Praying the Mass IV Living Mass - Mission
Monday 6 th November	Gift of the Spirit – vocation and fullness of life
Saturday 26 th November at 6pm Mass	Prayer for those to be Confirmed and, following the Mass, Rehearsal for Confirmation
Tuesday 28 th November, 7pm	Celebration of Confirmation (with Bishop Philip Pargeter)

<p>Summer Project</p> <p><i>This project can be continued after the summer, if you like, as your work as part of the Bishop Walsh Award.</i></p>	<p>Easter: Project</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose your project – a way in which you can serve the parish community, or your local community. • Choose something that involves you serving for c1hour a week during the Easter season. • Keep a photo diary of what you do, and write a short account of what you did and what you felt about it.
